Overview

The primary components of a solar panel are its solar cells. P-type or n-type solar cells mix crystalline silicon, gallium, or boron to create silicon ingot. Most panels on the market are made of monocrystalline, polycrystalline, or thin film ("amorphous") silicon. Each component plays a distinct role in optical protection, electrical energy conversion, mechanical support, and electrical connection.
